Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" of Joint Stock Company "Grodno Azot" (hereafter Branch "Khimvolokno Plant"), based on provisions of Regulation (EU) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 "On classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures", declares that polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (hereafter PAHs) are not intentionally used or added at the polyamide 6 and polymer composite materials production.

Despite the fact that PAHs are not intentionally added, this does not exclude the presence of their traces due to the presence of impurities in the components supplied by third parties.

This information has validity only at the time, when polyamide 6 or polymer composite material leaves manufacturing entity and does not refer to any additives, dyes, etc., added by a processor afterwards or at any stage of processing performed by a third party.

This declaration was drawn up and issued on the basis of the currently applicable laws and legal acts, as well as the information and expert knowledge available to Branch "Khimvolokno Plant".
