RoHS Declaration

(Directive 2011/65/EC "On the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electric and electronic equipment")

Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" of the Joint Stock Company "Grodno Azot" (hereinafter Branch "Khimvolokno Plant"), based on the provisions of Directive 2011/65/EC "On the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electric and electronic equipment" (RoHS2), including requirements of Delegated Commission Directive 2015/863 / EC (RoHS3), amending Annex II of Directive 2011/65 / EC, declares that for manufacturing of polyamide 6 and polymer composite materials the following substances are not intentionally used or added:

- heavy metals: cadmium, lead, chromium (VI) and mercury;
- polybrominated biphenyl (PBB);
- polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) including decabromodiphenyl ether (decaBDE);
- diethylhexylphthalate (DEHP);
- butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP);
- dibutyl phthalate (DBP);
- diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP).

This information is valid only when polyamide 6 or polymer composite material leave the production facility and does not apply to any additives, pigments, etc. subsequently added by a processor or at any stage of processing performed by a third party.

Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" additionally declares, that Directive WEEE 2012/19/EC on wastes of electric and electronic equipment (hereinafter - EEE) is not directly related to polyamide 6 and polymer composite materials, as the specified Directive WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) applies to finished articles, and is aimed at manufacturers and distributors of EEE, and not at the materials suppliers.

Thus, Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" cannot declare the compliance with Directive 2012/19/EC.

All the data provided by Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" concerning polyamide 6 and polymer composite materials is considered to be reliable, however Branch "Khimvolokno Plant" assumes no responsibility for further processing of polyamide 6 and polymer composite materials as well as for establishing the compliance of final article with national and international regulations with regards to its application.

It is the sole responsibility of the customer to ensure that the ready article is suitable for its intended use.
